



## YOUTH TREE TEAM

Seeking high school students working towards making a difference in the environment of their community.

### OVERVIEW

The Keep Indianapolis Beautiful Youth Tree Team is a group of adult leaders and high school students who work to water and maintain trees planted in Marion County through our Community Forestry Program. The Youth Tree Team is a 7-week summer program, but there are opportunities to work weekends during the spring and fall.

Nine high school students will work alongside two adult leaders to water about 500 trees weekly during the summer. This is



an outdoor job that includes watering, mulching, staking, and planting trees. The applicant should be comfortable taking initiative, respectful, have an interest in the environment, take pride in his or her work, be responsible, be professional, and can work well in a team. The applicant should also be able to complete physical work daily.

**REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must be currently enrolled in high school, eligible for a work permit, and at least 14 years of age. Applicants should be hard workers, consistent in attendance and punctuality, unbiased towards gender, creed, or ethnicity, and possess a strong desire to learn and grow. Applicants must also be able to carry two, 40-pound buckets of water while walking several hundred feet.
