



YOUTH TREE TEAM - LEADER

Seeking adults looking to make a difference in the environment and youth of their community.

OVERVIEW

The Keep Indianapolis Beautiful Youth Tree Team is a group of adult leaders and high school students who work to water and maintain trees planted in Marion County through our Community Forestry Program. It is a 7-week summer program, with opportunities to work weekends during the spring and fall.

Two adult leaders will work with nine high school students to water about 500 trees weekly during the summer. This is a lead-by-example position where leaders work side-by-side with the youth to get the trees watered, mulched and staked. The leaders drive a 15-passenger van with a trailer to sites around the city. Leaders will be trained to safely drive the vehicles and how to properly maintain trees. Leaders are responsible for their crew's safety at all times. Leaders also must motivate their crews to ensure the assigned work is finished. Leaders will evaluate the youths' performance weekly to help them earn a Work Skills Certificate.



REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must have a valid U.S. Driver's License and be at least 19 years of age. Applicants must also have a high school diploma or the equivalent thereof. Applicants should be hard workers, consistent in attendance and punctuality, unbiased towards gender, sexual orientation, or ethnicity, and possess a strong desire to learn and grow. Applicants must also be able to carry two, 40-pound buckets of water while walking several hundred feet.
