






Tap the MORE icon (≡ for Google phone)




Tap the magnifying glass to search SEARCH for a project



Tap PROJECTS to add a project




Start typing the name of your project and select it




Select JOIN on the project page



You will see the the project is listed under the JOINED tab




Tap the BACK arrow

Tap the CAMERA icon (+ for Google phone)




Capture an image of the pollinator(s) in your area (or upload from library)




Tap WHAT DID YOU SEE to enter species information




Make a best guess to prompt the app about what species you saw




Turn on the switch (or check the box for Google phone)




Tap projects to make sure that your project is selected
